

Remember when we used to adjust each buoy in the slalom course for the changing tide? Anyone who did this appreciates the self-adjusting course that Bill Helliwell invented and has maintained for the past several years.

Bill has improved on his original design with a system that uses three sections of PVC pipe — the white pipe used for lawn sprinkler systems — that telescopes up and down with the varying tide. Not only is this setup far less expensive, it's far simpler, more robust, easier to repair, and is practically maintenance-free.

As good as the current system has

been, it has its weak points. There are a lot of moving parts. The anchor bolts are rusting through. When a buoy is hit by a boat, the whole sub-system usually has to be replaced, and there are only a few people who know how to do this.

And we only have one person — Bill himself — who knows how to build and repair these systems. Bill's been repairing systems roughly 2 - 3 times each month, and each repair takes an hour.

Bill installed a prototype of the new system on the right-hand green "55" marker at the dock end of the course. You've probably noticed the two green buoys right next to each other. It's been in place for over a year, and Bill has worked out most of the kinks. About a month ago, Bill and crew installed a new system for the right-hand 55 at the breakwater end of the course (because the anchor bolt has rusted through).

The board will be presented the details and a cost analysis to make a decision, so we can keep one of our most important assets in good working order for years to come.

Next time you see Bill, be sure to thank him for all his hard work!
